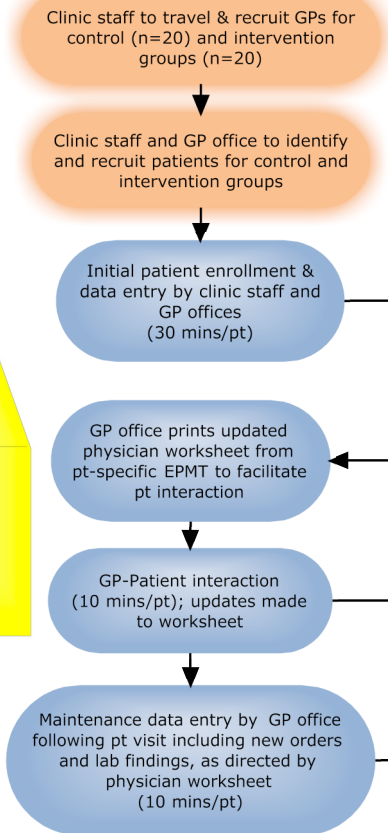


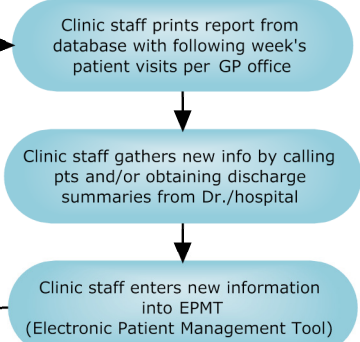
Global Flow Algorithm

The **physician worksheet** guides GPs through the current recommended guidelines for the mgmt of DM, dyslipidemia, HTN and CKD by making recommendations for lab monitoring, lifestyle changes, drug therapy, patient education and referrals, if required

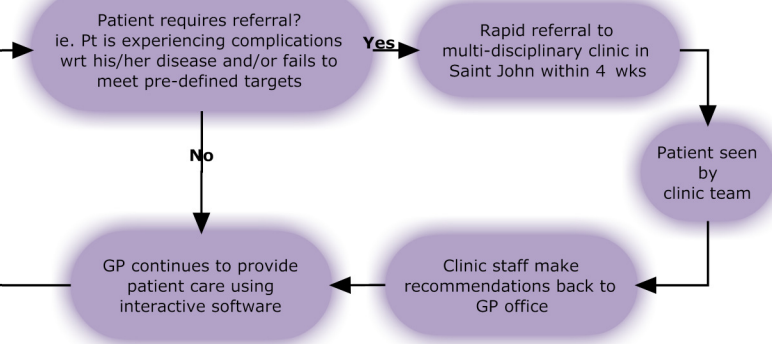

Randomization: Practices will be matched as closely as possible by location & size and randomized by a draw within their respective cohorts to either group (I or C). Only GPs in the intervention group will receive recommendations from the system on how to treat their pts based on the compilation of clinical practice guidelines and access to the multi-disciplinary clinic.

Hypothesis: The implementation of a multi-system disease mgmt model integrating electronic feedback to GPs & quick access to a multi-disciplinary specialist team demonstrates a stat. sig. improvement in achieving primary outcomes related to the mgmt of type 2 DM & its complications as defined as reduction in BP, slowing of GFR decline & reduction in A1C as compared to the comparator group matched for size & location of GP office.
